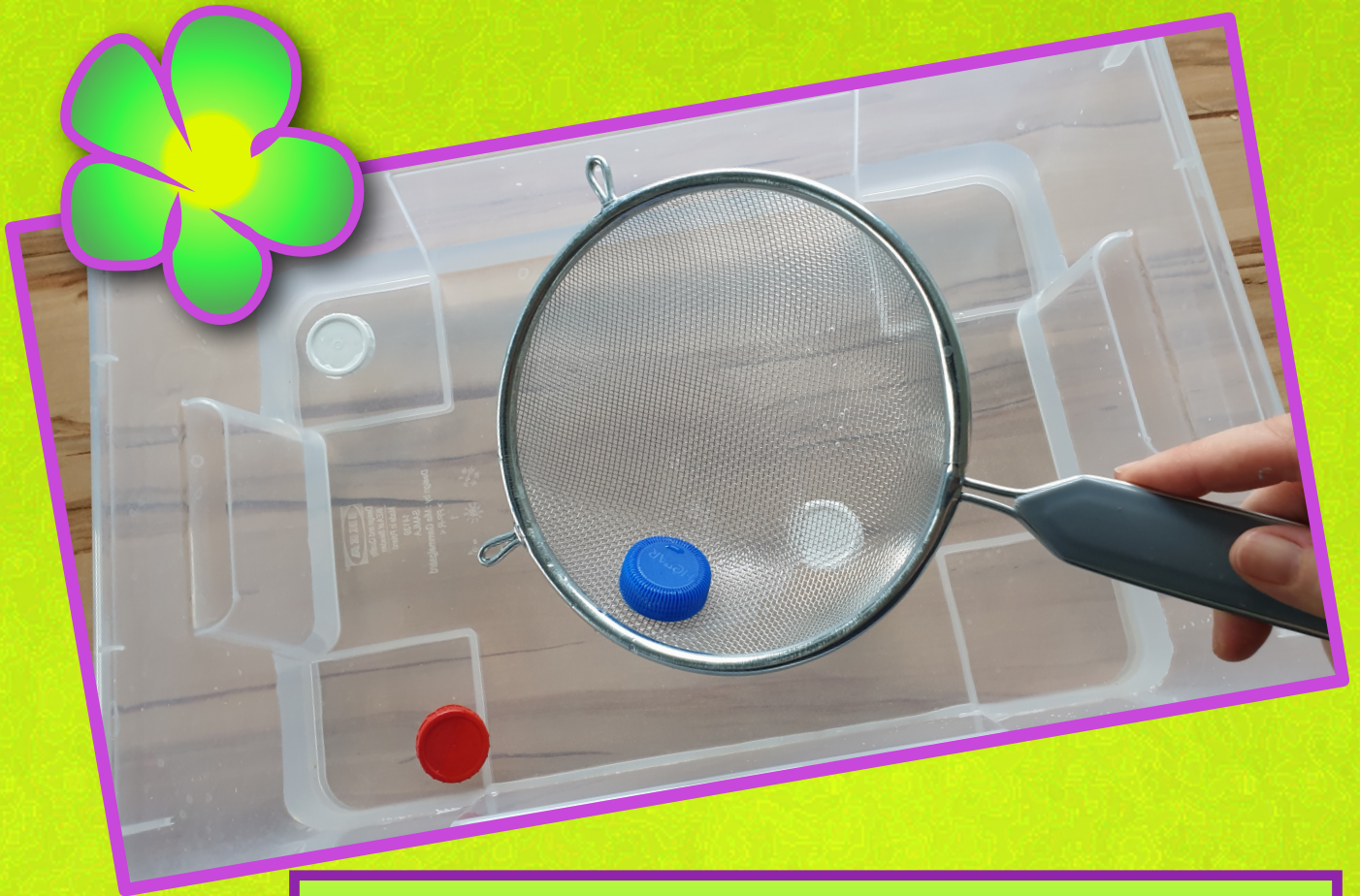




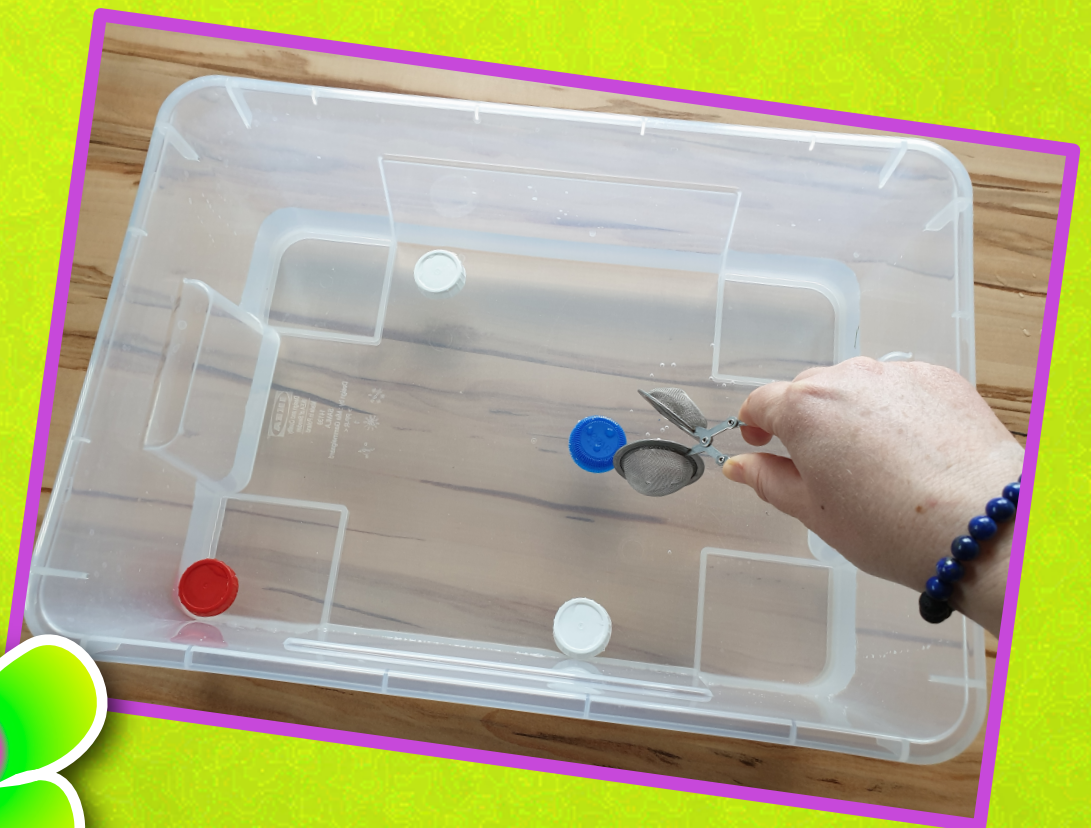
Put beans, lentils or rice in a box. Now you can fill a glass or another bin with a spoon.

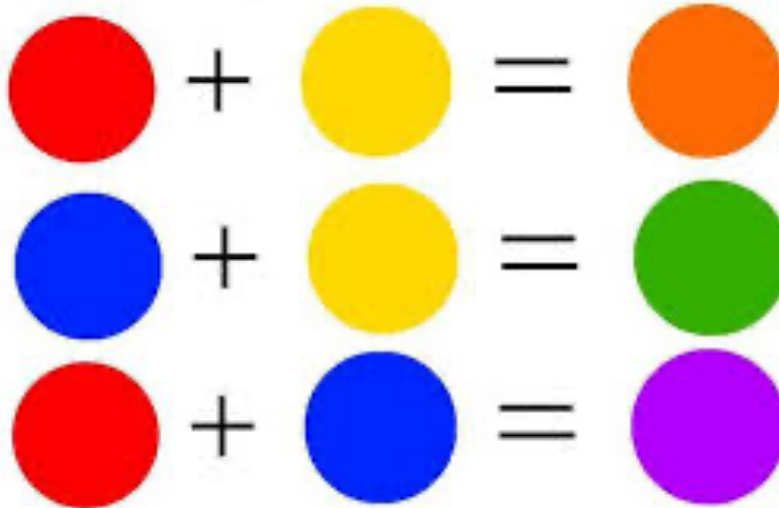

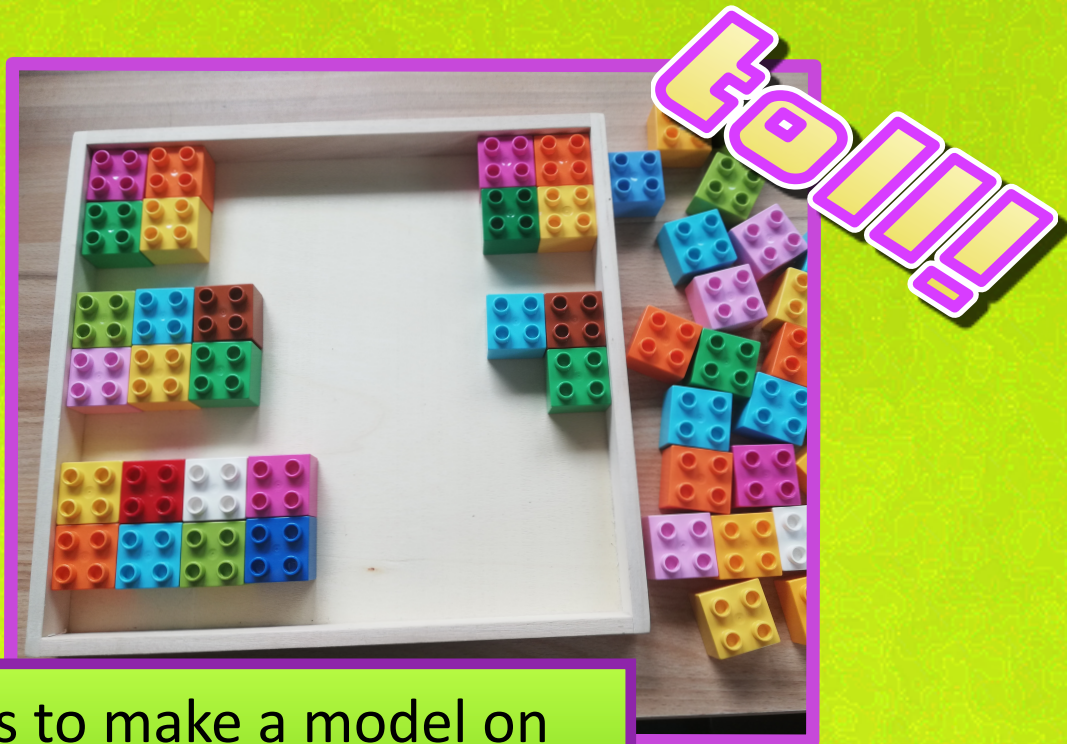


Mix colours with gouache

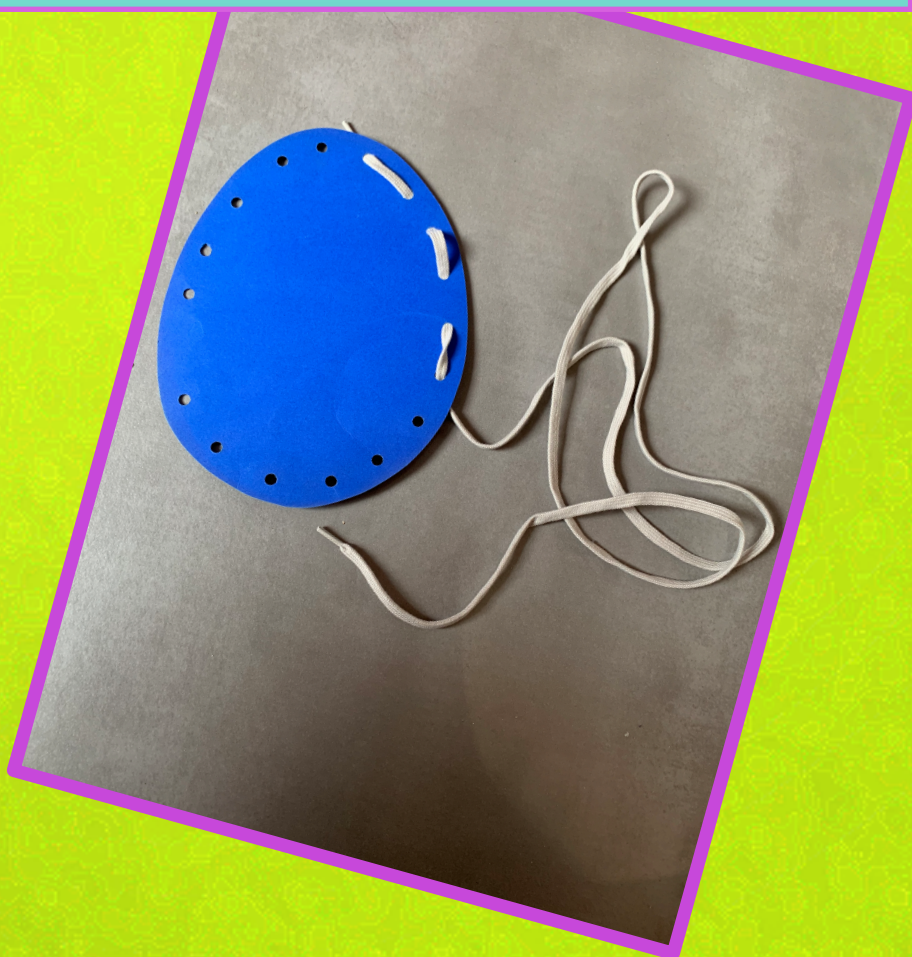

Fix socks with clothespin.





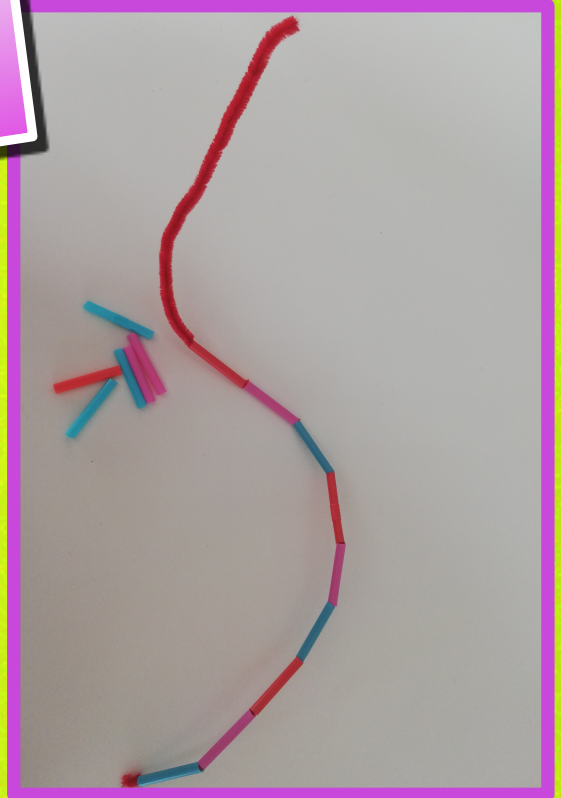
Cut out an egg and make holes around using a punch. Thread it with a lace.



Use rubber, straws or pearls to put them on or around a stick or a paper roll.

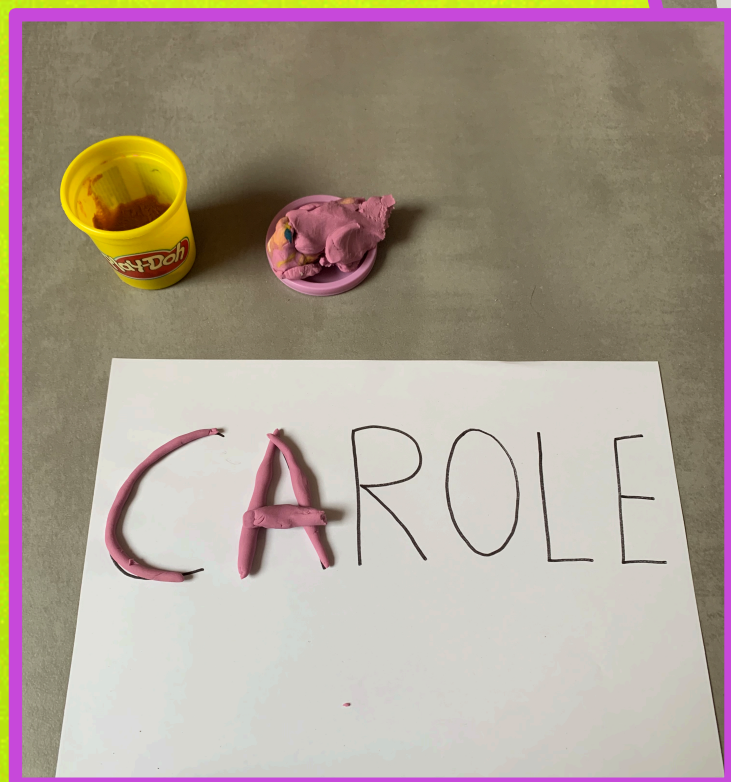
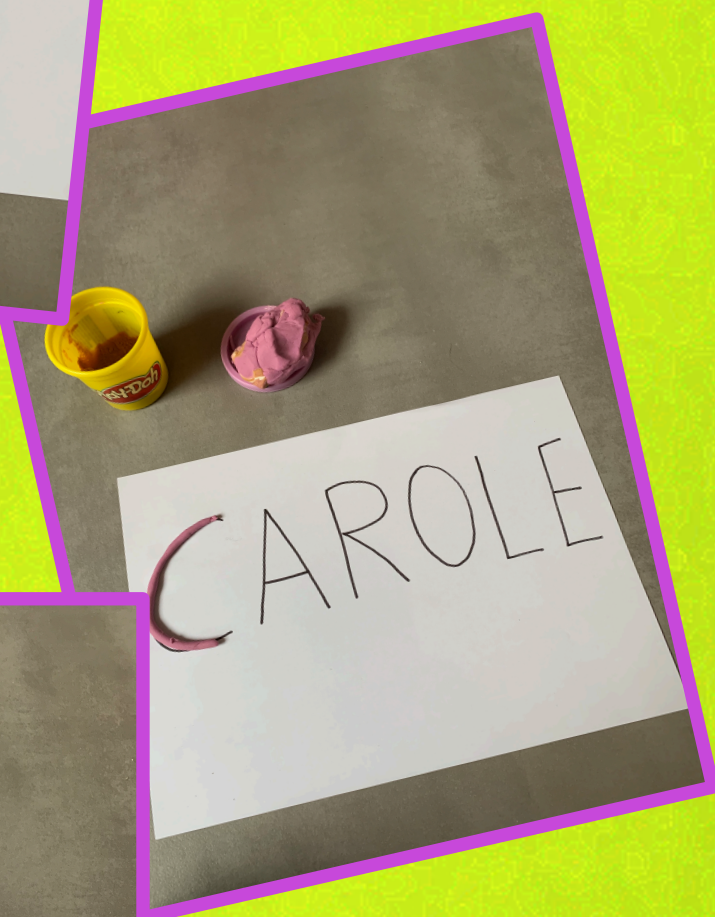
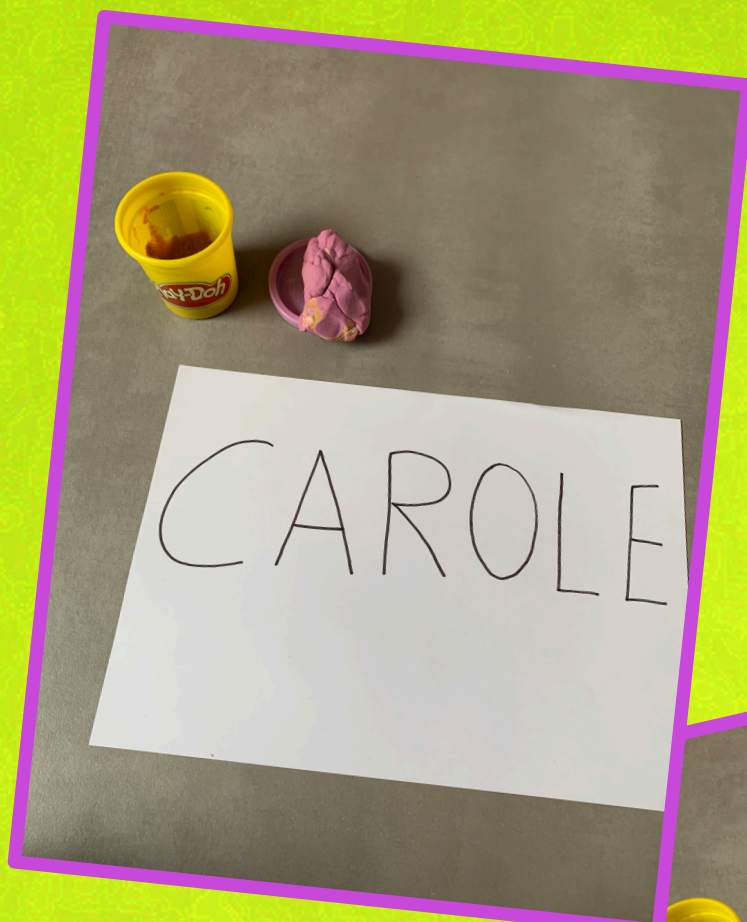
